Hello TT/XT 500 Enthusiast,

This year, we will be recognising the 40th Anniversary since the release of the 2nd model of the TT and XT 500's back in 1977. We will be holding the event in the beautiful Barossa Valley at the Bethany Reserve. We will be running just one ride on Saturday 28th and a dinner in the evening followed by the Show'n'Display day on Sunday 29th.

Saturday

The ride will start from the Bethany Reserve at approximately 9:45am on Saturday morning, so try to be there from 9.30am, so we know exact numbers attending the ride. It would be great to let us know if you will be attending, as seating is limited and booking numbers are essential. Please also keep in mind the Tanunda Caravan Park, which will cater for all your needs and is very close to the Bethany Reserve. As a special feature again at this year's Muster, we are hoping to have Sofie Kraft and Haydon Ahrens doing a 'Trials Display'. Sofie is representing Australia as part of the team competing in the 2017 Trials des Nation for the second time which is to be held in Spain in late September.

We didn't have too many last year and with mailing prices always increasing, we would really like to utilise this modern and cost effective form of communication.

We are still currently in the process of setting up the 'stand-alone' Muster site, which is basic at this stage but one we can build on throughout the coming years.
